AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO AUTO THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000 AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF AND A RELATED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The 2020 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado is amended by the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Auto Theft Prevention Authority in the amount of \$200,000 to assist in improving and supporting motor vehicle theft prevention programs or programs for the enforcement or prosecution of motor vehicle theft crimes. The expenditure of such funds is hereby authorized. (Fund 180)

SECTION 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Colorado relating to such grant, in terms acceptable to the City Manager and with the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effectively immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
