Intent

- Changing the name to Energy and Carbon Management Commission;
- Broadening COGCC regulatory authority to include the regulation of carbon capture and storage; certain geothermal resource operations and interstate underground natural gas storage facilities.

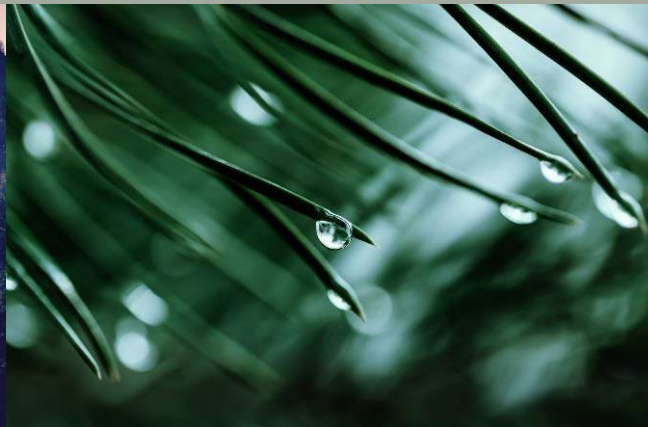
Study 1- Hydrogen Storage

The commission shall conduct a study to develop recommendations for the regulations and permitting of hydrogen storage in subsurface formations; the transportation of hydrogen through pipelines and hydrogen operations.

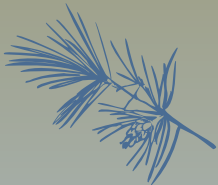


Study 2 - Pipeline Siting

The commission shall conduct a study to examine the existing administrative structure for pipeline siting and safety regulations for operations related to or interconnected with the Commissions directive and regulatory responsibilities.

GEMMs 2 – Rulemaking Changes

- Allow facilities to buy credits or reduce emissions at other facilities or affiliates;
- 18 Facilities – some have reduced by 150%
- 2015 - 962,525 tons
- 2022 – 951,858 tons
- Suncor – 1% reduction
