Subject: Resolution Authorizing Intergovernmental Agreement between Adams County and Commerce City Regarding Cost-Sharing for Dahlia Street Improvement Project
Date: November 6, 2020

Purpose

Approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Adams County and Commerce City for cost sharing for the Dahlia Street Project between East 69th Avenue and State Highway 224. Resolution No. 2020-88 authorizes the Mayor and the City Clerk to sign the IGA with Adams County, substantially in the form attached, on behalf of the City.

Background / Summary

Dahlia Street between East 69th Avenue and State Highway 224 (74th Avenue) has a mixture of unincorporated Adams County and Commerce City residents. The overall objective of this project is to improve roadway safety, capacity, mobility, pedestrian facilities, and the drainage system on Dahlia Street. The design for the project will be advertised and awarded in the first quarter of 2021. The construction for the project is expected to begin in 2022 and be completed in 2023. Adams County is responsible for design and construction of the project.

The attached IGA outlines the City's contribution as \$946,830 with a cap of \$1,000,000 toward the project. The estimated cost for the project is \$3,070,800. The City has budgeted \$1,000,000 for the project.

Financial Impact

The Dahlia Street Project is funded from the Capital Improvements and Preservation Plan budget and funding from Adams County. The total estimated budget is \$3,070,800 with a maximum contribution from Commerce City of \$1,000,000 and Adams County funding the rest of the project.

Staff Recommendation

Approve IGA authorizing Commerce City to contribute \$1,000,000 to the Dahlia Street Project between East 69th Avenue and State Highway 224.
