

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A CITY COUNCIL POLICY TO GOVERN
ELECTRONIC MEETING PROCEDURES AS COUNCIL POLICY #CP-26**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City enacted certain policies pursuant to Section 4.27 of the City Charter, which provides that the City Council “shall determine its own organization, rules and order of business ...”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend its Council Policies to enact a new policy governing Electronic Meeting Procedures by members of the City Council, as Council Policy #CP-26.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Adoption and Effective Date. This resolution, adopting Council Policy #CP-26 for Electronic Meeting Procedures, as set forth in Exhibit A, shall become effective upon passage of an ordinance amending the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code to expressly allow meetings to occur via electronic means.
