AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, BY TRANSFERRING \$400,000 FROM THE WATER RIGHTS ACQUISITION FUND TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND PRESERVATION PLAN FUND (CIPP) FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE BUFFALO RUN GOLF COURSE WELL PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURES THEREOF

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. An amendment is made to the 2022 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, by transferring \$400,000 from the Water Rights Acquisition Fund to the Capital Improvements and Preservation Fund (CIPP) to be used for costs associated with the Buffalo Run Golf Course Well Project (Fund 395),

Section 2. The expenditure of the funds herein transferred and appropriated is hereby authorized.

Section 3. This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and the general public.
