

ORDINANCE NO. 2747

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-5005 OF CHAPTER 12 OF THE COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE TO MODIFY THE SOLICITATIONS ON POSTED PROPERTY PROVISION

WHEREAS, the City finds that excessive, unwanted solicitations on posted properties create disturbances, pose potential safety concerns, and infringe upon residents' privacy;

WHEREAS, the City has a substantial and legitimate interest in protecting the peace and security of its residents, while also balancing the constitutional rights of individuals engaging in expressive activities;

WHEREAS, the City has a continued interest in establishing and enforcing regulations regarding "No Soliciting" signage that will assist residents, businesses, and enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the City finds and determines that amending the City's existing solicitation ordinance is in the best interest of the public for the welfare of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 12-5005 of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective pursuant to Section 5.4 of the Charter.
