# **Procurement Policy**



Threshold	Solicitation Required	Authorization Required
Up to \$5,000	Quotes Recommended	Division Manager or above
\$5,000.01-\$50,000	Minimum of three quotes required	Department Director or above
\$50,000.01 - \$250,000	Formal solicitation required	City Manager
Over \$250,000	Formal solicitation required	City Council

## **Procurement Policy**



### **Council's Role**

- Review Staff Recommendations
- Authorize the city manager to execute the contract

### Staff's Role

- Develop procurement in compliance with policy
- Evaluate responses based on established criteria
- Recommend award to Council
- Execute contract
- Complete project


