

A RESOLUTION APPROVING SALARY INCREASE FOR CITY MANAGER JASON ROGERS

WHEREAS, the City Council appointed Jason Rogers to the position of City Manager effective December 13, 2022, and memorialized said employment by the “Employment Agreement Appointing a City Manager for the City of Commerce City, Colorado” (the “Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the Agreement states that Mr. Rogers’ annual base salary is \$250,000, but the Agreement authorizes City Council to approve salary increases; and

WHEREAS, the City Council completed its 2023 performance evaluation for Mr. Rogers and wishes to approve an equity adjustment or an increase his annual base salary in the amount of \$_____, for a total new annual base salary of \$_____.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.
