

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) selected Felsburg, Holt and Ullevig (“Contractor”) to provide transportation planning and engineering professional services for the update of the City’s Transportation Master Plan (“Project”);

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the City Council approved an agreement with Felsburg, Holt and Ullevig to complete the Transportation Master Plan Update project;

WHEREAS, the Agreement was entered into for an amount not to exceed TWO HUNDRED FIFTY FOUR THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE AND NO CENTS (\$254,775.00);

WHEREAS, the cost to the City for the project covered by the Agreement will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City’s procurement policies and the City Manager’s commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00;

WHEREAS, the Contractor encountered inaccuracies with the land use data and required additional data analysis which requires an increase of the not to exceed amount of the agreements with the Contractors through amendment to the original agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the Agreement through December 31, 2025;

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Agreement with the Contractor to extend the term and increase the amount of compensation available under the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, except as modified by the First Amendment, the Parties intend that the remaining terms and conditions in the original Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Negotiate. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize the details of an amendment with Felsburg, Holt and Ullevig,

SECTION 3. Execution and Attestation. Upon successful finalization of the amendment and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the amendment on behalf of the City.
