## RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE PARKS, RECREATION AND GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE

## NO. 2016-117

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2016-12 on March 21, 2016, to establish the Parks, Recreation and Golf Advisory Committee to provide citizens with the opportunity to contribute to making Commerce City a Quality Community for a Lifetime promoting active, healthy lifestyles through parks, recreation and golf; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Golf Advisory Committee has recommended modifying the membership provisions of Resolution No. 2016-12 to allow all citizen member seats to be filled by citizen representatives of any age.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Paragraph 3 of Resolution No. 2016-12 is amended to read as follows:

<u>Membership</u>. The committee will consist of up to thirteen (13) members as follows: two (2) City Council members plus eleven (11) representatives of the community at large of the age of at least thirteen (13). Members shall serve without compensation. Each member shall be a resident of the City, an employee of a business in the City, or an owner of property in the City. City employees and Council members, their immediate family members, and other elected officials are not eligible for membership except as stated in this resolution.

- 2. Resolution No. 2016-12 is repealed and replaced to the extent it is not consistent with this resolution.
- 3. This resolution shall not affect any appointments to or decisions made by the Parks, Recreation and Golf Advisory Committee before its effective date.
