THIRD AMENDMENT TO EXTEND INTERIM EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

This Third Amendment to the Interim Employment Agreement ("Third Amendment") is made and entered into effective the 1st day of October, 2022 (the "Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, a Colorado home rule municipality whose address is 7887 East 60th Avenue, Commerce City, Colorado (the "City"), and Matthew R. Hader ("Mr. Hader"), to amend and extend the Employment Agreement of Matthew R. Hader as Interim City Attorney for the City of Commerce City, Colorado, made effective November 19, 2021 (the "Agreement"), and as previously amended pursuant to that Amendment to Extend Interim Employment Agreement, made effective the 19th day of May, 2022, and the Second Amendment, made effective August 1, 2022. In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained in this Third Amendment, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. <u>Term</u>: The Term of the Agreement is extended through February 28, 2023, subject to the terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement, as previously amended.

2. <u>Payout of General Lave</u>. Mr. Hader shall be permitted to cash out any unused general leave to effectively reduce his any carry over into the 2022-23 budget year to no more than forty (40) hours.

3. <u>Survival</u>. The terms of section 2 this Third Amendment will survive the termination of the Agreement, as amended.

4. <u>Remainder of Agreement in Full Force and Effect</u>. Except as otherwise provided by this Second Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect and shall apply to this Second Amendment.

5. <u>Authority</u>. The parties represent and warrant that they have taken all actions necessary to legally authorize the undersigned signatories to execute this Second Amendment on behalf of the parties and to bind the parties to its terms.

6. <u>Counterparts</u>; <u>Execution</u>. This Second Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each deemed to be an original, and, taken together will constitute one and the same instrument. Signature pages may be executed via "wet" signature or electronic mark and the executed signature pages may be delivered using pdf or similar file type transmitted via electronic mail, cloud based server, e-signature technology or other similar electronic means.

7. <u>Headings</u>. Paragraph headings used in this Second Amendment are for convenience of reference and shall in no way control or affect the meaning or interpretation of any provision of this Second Amendment.
