AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CDOT) GRANT FUNDS FOR \$760,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE POTOMAC ST/O'BRIEN CANAL BRIDGE AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2021 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) grant for \$760,000. The funds are to be used for the construction of the Potomac St/O'Brien Canal Bridge (Fund 395).
