

ORDINANCE NO. 2407

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$422,541 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, Beginning with the 2016-2017 program year, the city became a direct recipient of funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. This ordinance accepts the funds awarded for program year 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. The 2022 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado is amended to recognize the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$422,541 for public services, public works, economic development, housing rehabilitation, and/or administration costs and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized (Fund 395).

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
