Background

- The *2009 Municipal Trash and Recyclables Collection Agreement* expired on December 31, 2013
- The contract was extended for one additional year with City Council's direction to go out to in 2015
- This presentation is intended to provide service options for the City Council to consider for inclusion in the formal Request for Proposal
- The following options are based on City Council's input received over the years



Trash Contract Base Service

Base Service:

- Unlimited weekly trash service
- Bi-weekly curbside recycling
- Two (2) 18-gallon recycling totes provided per unit for recycling
- Homeowners provide their own bags and trash receptacles
- Free large item pick-up
- Trash and recycling services for all City facilities



Trash Contract Add Alternates

Add Alternates:

- Eliminate free large item pick-up
- Eliminate fee large item pick-up & provide one city-wide clean-up event
- Provide one (1) 96-gallon refuse container per unit
- Provide one (1) 96-gallon recycling container per unit

- Issue RFP – 5/15/14
- Review responses with City Council – 6/9/14
- Award contract – 7/7/14
- Implement contract – 1/1/15
