AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY PUBLIC ART FUNDING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City adopted the Public Art Master Plan by Resolution 2013-2 in March, 2013 because City Council believes it advances the City's vision of creating a "Quality Community for a Lifetime" by highlighting public spaces within the community, strengthening community identity and pride, illustrating the rich visual heritage of the region, elevating the quality of urban living, providing opportunities for education and learning, and stimulating economic growth; and

WHEREAS, in order to fully realize the benefits of the Public Art Master Plan it is necessary to adopt a mechanism to fund the acquisition and maintenance of art within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City Public Art Funding Program, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, sets forth a reasonable and responsible mechanism for funding the acquisition and maintenance of public art.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Commerce City Public Art Funding Program, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted.
