

**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ADOPTION OF  
THE COMMERCE CITY YOUTH MASTER PLAN  
NO. 2015-14**

WHEREAS, the City created the Commerce City Youth Commission in 2012 to be an advisory body to city council on issues affecting youth our city, with a mission to serve as the voice of Commerce City youth by generating and acting on ideas to inspire a better community today and tomorrow; and

WHEREAS, Adams County has the highest proportion of children to adults and Commerce City is home to about 25 schools and more than 12,000 students, families face more challenging circumstances and generally face many of the same challenges regardless of the school; and

WHEREAS, one of the Commerce City Youth Commission's key tasks was to create a youth master plan to help provide a strategic roadmap for how the city could best support successful youth outcomes in the community and through existing Adams County data and studies, peer focus groups and brainstorming, the youth commission identified five areas of focus for youth in the city that need to be addressed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City Youth Master Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, sets forth a strategic roadmap to assess and guide city-driven youth programming and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Commerce City Youth Master Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted.
