AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2015 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$284,618 FOR EAST 72ND AVENUE CORRIDOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2015 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of grant funds from the State of Colorado Safe Routes to School in the amount of \$284,618 to be used for the East 72nd Avenue Corridor Infrastructure Improvement Project. (Fund 395)
