Z-919-15: Manuel and Deborah Ornelas request to annex and rezone from ADCO and Commence City AG to Commerce City I-2 for the property located at 7420 E. 86th Avenue. Ms. Stevens introduced the case and asked that the record reflect that the file contained the relevant notification and publication information. Mr. Draper reviewed the staff report and the presentation, including the Development Review Team's recommendation for approval, subject to one condition. He noted that a concurrent annexation case AN-234-15 was being considered by City Council and subdivision case S-632-15 was under administrative review.

Mr. Ed Jennings, 1194 Dahlia Street, Denver, Colorado stated that the zone change is necessary to facilitate the development on the property. The Planning Commission had no questions and Chairman McFarlin opened the hearing to the public. Noting that no person indicated a desire to testify, he closed the hearing and requested a motion.
