WHEREAS, Colorado's CSNCs and RHCs provide essential health care treatment and preventive services through an estimated 1,125,000 visits to approximately 344,000 Coloradans annually; and

WHEREAS, clinics like Kids First Health Care are safety net providers to people and communities in need, serving the uninsured, underinsured or those insured through public programs, relying on complex and vulnerable funding streams to create innovative solutions that deliver patient-centered, high quality care in an efficient and effective manner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of Commerce City declares August 17 – 21, 2015, as SAFETY NET CLINIC WEEK, expressing our gratitude to Kids First Health Care and other facilities for their time, energy and commitment to provide essential health care services to this community and underserved populations throughout Colorado.
