Purpose

Ordinance No. 1525, Article IV, Sec. 12-83

The proceeds of the surcharge herein authorized shall be deposited in a special fund and used solely for purposes as determined by the City Manager for community justice programs and victim and witness assistance programs in the City of Commerce City.



Background

- 1. Ordinance 1525 approved Dec. 15, 2003
- 2. Effective Jan. 1, 2004
- 3. 30% of the fines and costs assessed, provided the total fine and surcharge shall not exceed the maximum fine authorized for the violation
- 4. Surcharge is not subject to waiver or suspension
- 5. Proceeds of the surcharge are used solely for purposes determined by City Manager for community justice programs and victim/witness assistance programs

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Background

- 2004 2006 Funds used solely for victim advocate program
- 2007 court probation expenses and the Link Program were added
- 2009 a separate division was created for the Community Justice Program and several programs were added.
