RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT REGARDING A JOINT WATER COMMISSION

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2004, the City of Commerce City (the "City") and South Adams County Water and Sanitation District (the "District") entered into an intergovernmental agreement (the "2004 IGA") that recognized the importance of public water and wastewater service within the City and the District; and

WHEREAS, in 2004 IGA, the City and the District agreed to cooperate with each other in the pursuit and development of additional water projects;

WHEREAS, in 2007, by Resolution No. 2007-30, the City approved an intergovernmental agreement creating of a joint water commission to facilitate the implementation of the 2004 IGA and to provide for the efficient development of necessary public and wastewater services to the City and surrounding areas (the "2007 IGA");

WHEREAS, the City and the District desire to confirm and update the 2007 IGA and the joint water commission established in 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City has considered the Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Joint Water Commission attached as Exhibit "A" (the "Water Commission IGA") and determined that it is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Water Commission IGA is hereby approved.
- 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Water Commission IGA on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
