This 27-year investment has created a vibrant cultural landscape across the seven-county region and injected billions of dollars into our economy.

## Adams County and the Scientific & Cultural Facilities District

Since 1988, organizations across Adams County have benefited from the shared contributions of citizens from across the seven county special district. To date SCFD has provided more than \$14.9 million for county-level investment in local arts and culture organizations.
