ORDINANCE NO. 2102

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-3005 OF THE COMMERCE CITY REVISED MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL TERMS FOR THE YOUTH COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City established a Youth Commission in 2012 for the purpose of empowering, supporting and informing the youth of the City so that they can be productive members of the community; and

WHEREAS, youth members who join at the minimum age of 13 and would like to continue through the maximum age of 19 should be provided the chance to do so through six years or three terms of two years each.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City wishes to amend subsection (c) of Section 2-3005 to increase the number of terms a voting member of the youth commission may serve to three (3) terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2-3005(c) of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

* * *

(c) Terms of Office. Except for vacancies in unexpired terms, which shall be filled in accordance with the charter, the appointment of city council members whose terms shall coincide with the organization meetings of the city council, and any appointments made to ensure the appropriate staggering of terms, members shall be appointed for a period of two (2) years. Youth members who reach the age of 19 while in office shall be deemed to have resigned their position as of the date of their birthday. No voting member except for the volunteer coordinator may be appointed to serve more than three (3) terms on the youth commission.
