RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR CHAMBERS ROAD BRIDGE WIDENING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") desires to construct a public improvement project to widen the existing bridge over Second Creek on Chambers Road, north of 106th Avenue in order to provide an improved pedestrian crossing along the west side of the roadway ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a formal bidding process to select a contractor to construct the Project and, after reviewing all of the bids, City staff has determined that the lowest responsive and responsible bidder whose bid provides the best value to the City is Taylor Kohrs, LLC ("Contractor") and recommends the contract be awarded to the Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of the Services will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the award of the contract to the Contractor is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.
- 2. The Contractor's bid in the amount of \$416,701.82 is hereby accepted and the award of the contract for the construction of the Project in that amount to the Contractor is hereby approved, subject to the execution of a written contract.
- 3. Upon successful finalization of the contract and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract on behalf of the City.
