AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE TONY GRAMPSAS YOUTH SERVICES SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$79,119 FOR THE SUPPORT OF YOUTH MARIJUANA USE PREVENTION PROGRAM AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2016 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Tony Grampsas Youth Services Supplemental grant in the amount of \$79,119. The funds are to be used for the youth marijuana use prevention program. (Fund 180)
