AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING (POST) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 FOR THE SUPPORT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING BACKFILL AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2016 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the State of Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) grant in the amount of \$15,000. The funds are to be used for the support of law enforcement training backfill.
