AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY INCREASING THE BUDGETED REVENUES IN THE GENERAL FUND BY \$2,553,900 FOR THE RECOGNITION OF THE PAYMENT FROM ADAMS COUNTY AS THE ADMINSTRATOR OF THE IGA FOR THE ADAMS COUNTY AIRPORT COMMITTEE, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$1,398,021 TO THE CIPP FUND AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The 2016 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado is amended by increasing the budgeted revenues in the amount of Two Million Five Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$2,553,900) for recognition of the payment from Adams County and authorization transferring \$1,398,021 to the CIPP fund for Tower Road Utilities and Sidewalk Connectivity.
