BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR ADAMS COUNTY, STATE OF COLORADO

RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE ADAMS COUNTY DISTRICT 2 COMMISSIONER TO THE COMMERCE CITY URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY BOARD

WHEREAS, House Bill 15-1348, the Urban Redevelopment Fairness Act, amended Colorado Revised Statue (C.R.S.) § 31-25-101, et seq. to provide additional participation and review authority for counties, special districts, and school districts as it pertains to all urban renewal plans created on or after January 1, 2016, or any existing urban renewal plan that is amended or modified on or after January 1, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 31-25-104 (2)(a)(I), as amended, states that "[i]n order to represent the collective interests of the county and all taxing bodies levying a mill levy in one or more urban renewal areas managed by the authority...other than the municipality, one such commissioner on the authority must be appointed by the board of county commissioners of the county in which the territorial boundaries of the urban renewal authority area are located..."; and,

WHEREAS, it is the practice of Adams County to appoint a commissioner to an urban renewal authority board based upon the boundaries for the Adams County Commissioner District in which the urban renewal area or plan is located; and,

WHEREAS, the Commerce City Urban Renewal Authority (CCURA) has notified Adams County that it anticipates considering an urban renewal plan for the former Mile High Greyhound Park site, which is completely within Adams County Commissioner District 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the County Commissioner for Adams County Commissioner District 2 is hereby appointed to the CCURA Board.
