

**RESOLUTION APPROVING GREATER OUTDOORS COLORADO
INSPIRE GRANT AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for and received in October, 2015, as part of a coalition of government and non-profit entities (“NE Metro Coalition”), a planning grant through the Inspire Initiative of the State Board of the Great Outdoors Colorado Trust Fund (“GOCO”) to conduct planning for a project to improve youth and family connections with the outdoors in underserved communities near the Rocky Mountain Arsenal National Wildlife Refuge;

WHEREAS, the City now seeks to apply, as part of the NE Metro Coalition, for an implementation grant through GOCO for completion of a three (3) year implementation program of the projects identified in the planning process involving Places, Programs and Pathways to improve youth and family connections with the outdoors in underserved communities near the Rocky Mountain Arsenal National Wildlife Refuge (the “Projects”);

WHEREAS, the City finds that the Projects and the support of the GOCO Inspire Initiative implementation grant application is in the best interests of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the submission of the implementation grant application through GOCO for the Projects.
