RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AND THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") desires to establish a bus transit service route between various points within the southern portions of the City and has accepted a grant from the Regional Transportation District ("RTD") to do so; and

WHEREAS, the City and RTD wish to enter into an agreement attached hereto regarding funding, design and construction of various transit related improvements along the proposed route ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, RTD requires the City to pass a resolution authorizing the City to enter into the Agreement, and the City is authorized pursuant to § 29-1-203, C.R.S., as amended, and Section 4.13 of the Charter of the City of Commerce City to enter into intergovernmental agreements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that approval of the Agreement is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.
- 2. The Agreement, substantially in the form attached, is hereby approved.
- 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign, and the City Clerk to attest, the Agreement, substantially in the form attached on behalf of the City.
- 4. This resolution repeals and replaces Resolution 2016-98, which authorized a prior version of the intergovernmental agreement.
