About the Turnberry Public Art Project

Funding: \$15,884

- 1% of the construction costs: \$11,427
- Scientific and Cultural Facilities District grant: \$5,600

Project Expenses: \$15,884

- Future Maintenance and administration: \$1,143
- Sculpture purchase: \$10,800
- Concrete footers, site preparation and plaque: \$3,691
- Committee expenses: \$250

 - Set criteria
 - Reviewed 83 available sculptures
 - Selected 2 sculptures to recommend for purchase

Funding: \$11,427

- 1% of the construction costs: \$11,427

Project Expenses: \$11,427

- Future maintenance and administration: \$1,143
- Artwork proposal fee: \$200
- Artwork Commission: \$8,500
- Concrete footers, site preparation and plaque: \$1,512
- Committee expenses: \$72

 - Set criteria
 - Reviewed 80 available sculptures, invited artist to create proposal
 - Approved proposal and presented recommendation to Cultural Council

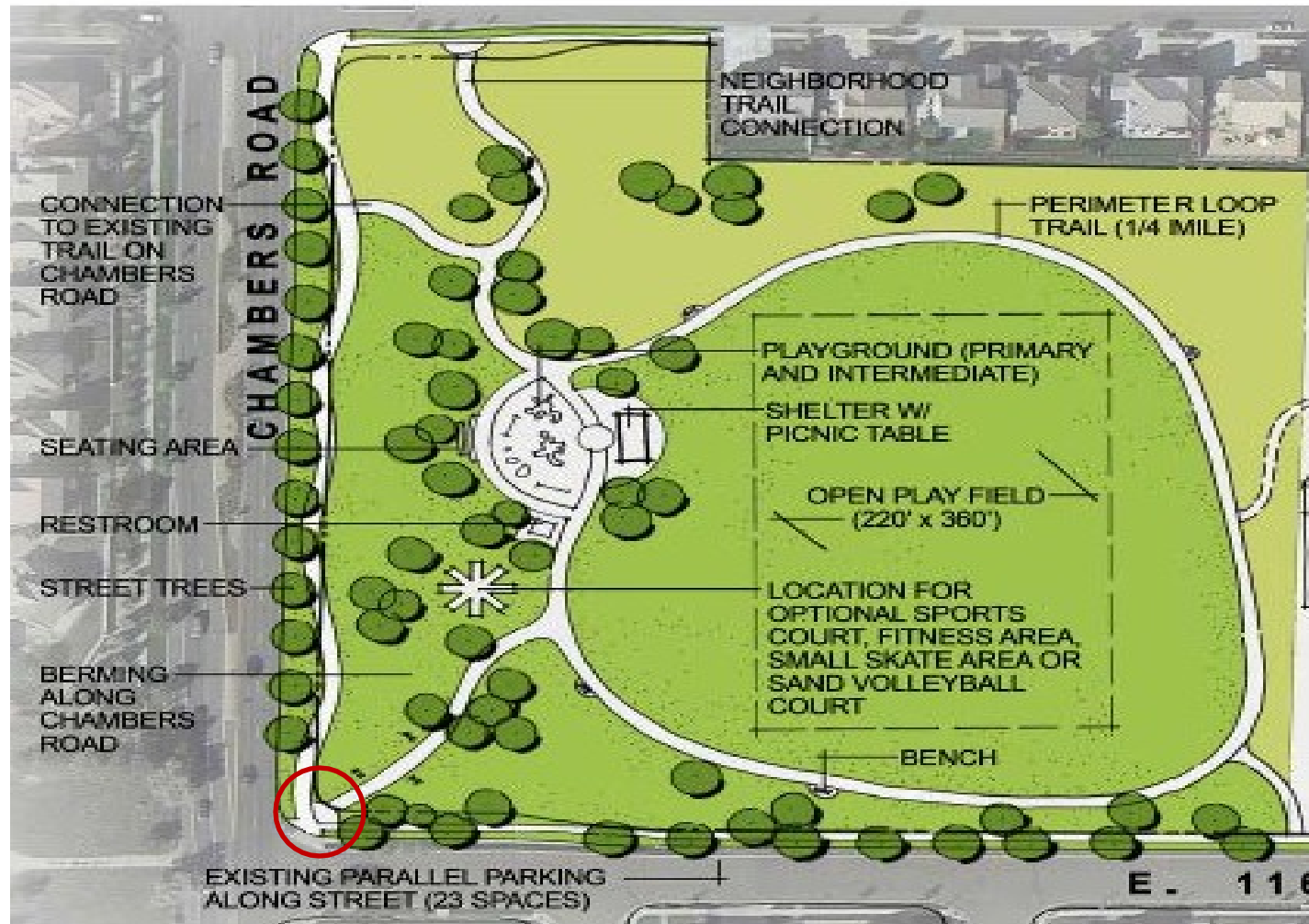
