

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PUBLIC ART INSTALLATION FOR
TURNBERRY PARK AND VILLAGES EAST PARK
NO. 2017-14**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (the “City”) approved a 1-percent public art funding program in 2014 to provide a means to fund the acquisition of public art by the City, which shall become part of the City’s public art collection; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Public Art Master Plan identifies a process for public art administration and commissioning of artworks in spaces accessible to the public; and

WHEREAS, the 1% funding requirement applies to the city’s voter-approved capital improvement program projects, including Turnberry Park and Villages East Park; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Public Art Master Plan, the Turnberry Park Public Art Selection Committee has selected public art proposals titled “Rendition” and "Matrix" by artist John Wilbar for placement in the park; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Public Art Master Plan, the Villages East Park Public Art Selection Committee has selected the public art proposal titled “Spyra Gyra” by artist Jerry Jaramillo for placement in the park; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2016 the Commerce City Cultural Council reviewed the selection committee’s recommendation for Turnberry Park and announced its unanimous support for the selection; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2017 the Commerce City Cultural Council reviewed the selection committee’s recommendation for Villages East park and announced its unanimous support for the selection; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Council formally advances the recommendations and requests City Council adopt a resolution in support of the public art commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby endorses the recommendation by the Commerce City Cultural Council and declares its support for the public art projects titled “Rendition,” "Matrix," by artist John Wilbar for placement in Turnberry Park and "Spyra Gyra" by artist Jerry Jaramillo for placement in Villages East Park consistent with the Commerce City Public Art Master Plan.
