Current Licensing Status

- Staff analyzing options for setbacks/caps
 - Possible study session April 24
 - 60 days from that point to adoption, through
 Planning Commission

 Map of licenses, pending licenses, and known pending submissions

Types of Businesses Affected

- Medical and/or Retail (Recreational)
- "Marijuana Businesses"
 - Stores (retail store; medical marijuana center)
 - Cultivation/grows
 - Manufacturing; testing; MIPs



What licensing action?

Submission

 9 city applications at varying stages but not "complete" as of March 20

Processing

 1 complete City application in process as of March 20

Issuance of licenses

- 7 approved pending certificates of occupancy as of March 20
- 10 operational as of March 20

MJ Moratorium History in C3

• June 2010 Emergency temporary moratorium (medical; 6 months)

• March 2011 Emergency temporary moratorium (medical; ran with state moratorium)

• May 2013 Temporary moratorium

(recreational; 18 months)

• July 2014 Extending temporary moratorium (recreational; repealed 6/1/15)
