## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SERVER, STORAGE, AND BACKUP UPGRADE SERVICES TO SENTINEL TECHNOLOGIES, INC. NO. 2017-32

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") desires to obtain server, storage and backup upgrade services, including the provision of related hardware and software, to ensure the provision of quality information technology services and systems for municipal purposes ("Services");

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a formal competitive public selection process to select a contractor to provide the Services and, after reviewing all of the proposals, City staff has determined that the respondent whose proposal provides the best value to the City is Sentinel Technologies, Inc. ("Contractor") and recommends the contract for the Services be awarded to the Contractor;

WHEREAS, the scope of work and associated costs will be determined upon negotiation of a final agreement, but the total cost is anticipated to be less than \$500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of the Services will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the award of the contract to the Contractor is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.
- 2. The award of the contract for the Services to Contractor is hereby approved, subject to the successful finalization of the services agreement on terms acceptable to the City Manager;
- 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize the details of the services agreement with the Contractor for an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00, subject to the appropriation of such funds.
- 4. Upon successful finalization of the contract and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract on behalf of the City.
