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BRIGHTON FIRE RESCUE

Impact Fee Proposal

- ▶ 150 square miles in Adams and Weld Counties
- Currently 5 fire stations
- ► 70 full-time employees
- ► About 6,000 calls each year
- ► About 3 sq miles in City now
- About 19 sq miles total with future planning
- ► IGA with City has established a fixed future boundary

OVERVIEW OF FIRE DISTRICT

- ▶ Public Safety Fairness Act enacted in June 2016
- ► Allows Fire Districts to impose Impact Fees on New Development
- Fees can only be used for Capital Facilities and Equipment
- Must be directly related to impact of new development
- ► Fees may vary by Fire District based on study
- ► Requires approval of City via IGA

NEW STATE LAW ON IMPACT FEES

- District hired third party consultant (BBC Research & Consulting)
- Purpose of study was to identify nexus and proposed fees
- ► Impact fees can only be used for growth related infrastructure

IMPACT FEE STUDY

- ► Impact Fee by Land Use
- ► Commercial (per 1,000 square feet) \$433
- ► Single family (per dwelling unit) \$688
- ► Multifamily (per dwelling unit) \$550

IMPACT FEE RECOMMENDATION

- ► Fire District is concurrently meeting with City of Brighton and Adams County
- Approval of Impact Fee would require an IGA between City and District
