





Program Summary


Commerce

- Approach creates a cycle of repairs to address:
 - ROUTINE maintenance
 - PREVENTIVE maintenance
 - CORRECTIVE maintenance
- Seven year cycle for local/neighborhood streets
- Weighted rating of Overall Condition Index (OCI) and various qualitative factors to rank arterial & collector streets












2017 PREVENTIVE - DSGP Area




2016 Accomplishments:


- *Partnership:* Implemented modified (less stiff) asphalt type for all new residential developments
- *Innovation:* Completed "pilot" program of slurry seal over older chip seal in Stillwater & Dunes neighborhoods
- Sustainability & Saving \$: Recycling milled asphalt for use in road shouldering efforts
- *Education:* Presentation on City's Program at the Colorado Asphalt Conference


Getting Better All the Time

2017 Planned Efforts:

- *Technology:* Evaluate in-place recycling as an option to mill & overlay
- *Partnership:* Research program to "reward" utility companies for completing repairs prior to City's maintenance & increasing requirements for any cuts made within 2-5 years after City maintenance
- Saving \$: Combine contracts with other agency(s) to get a better price
