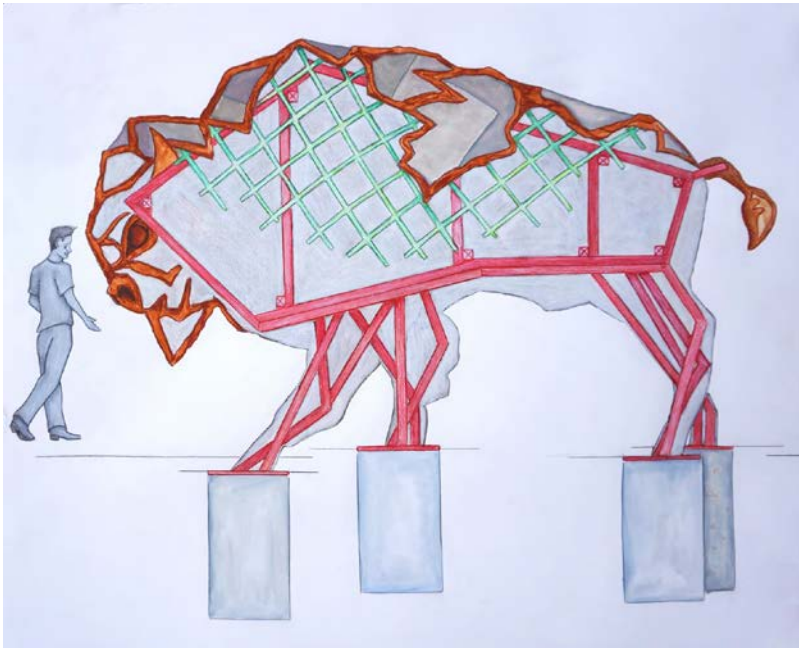

made from galvanized sheet metal and Steel with natural oxidization.

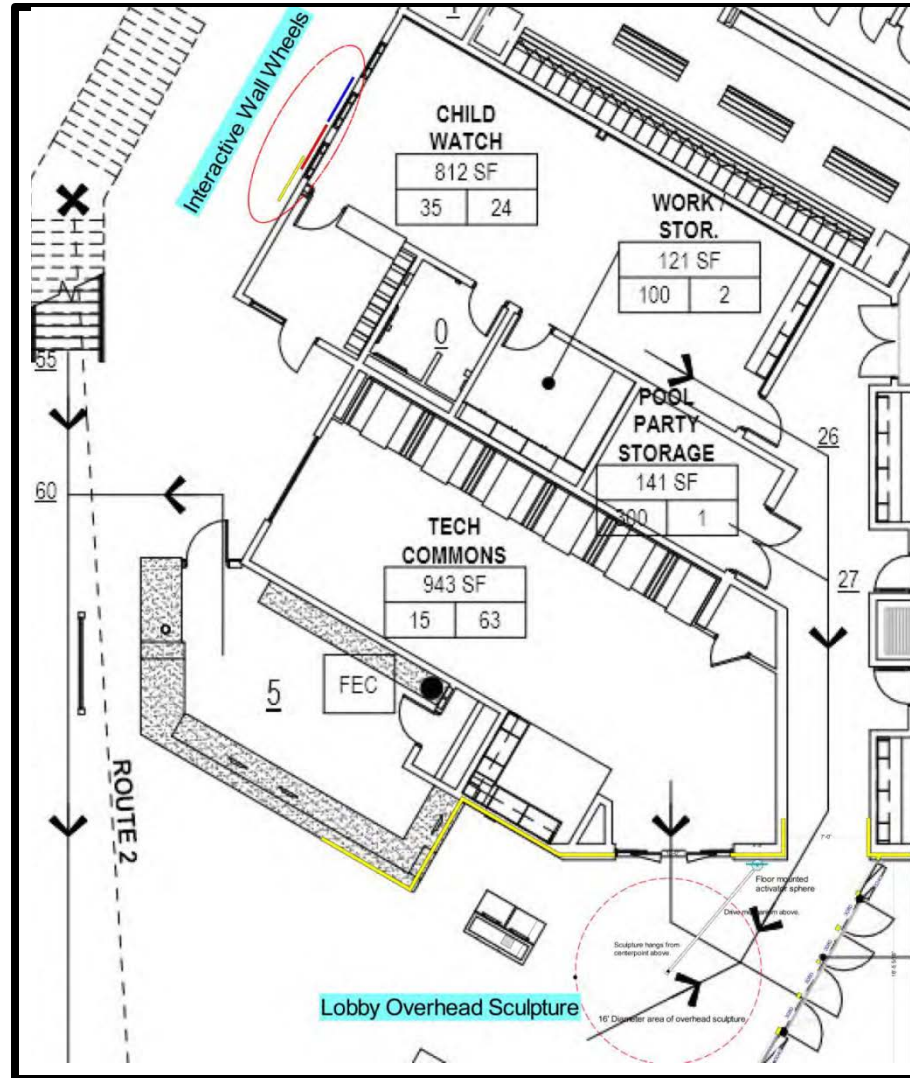
Each Bison sculpture will be about 12 feet tall, 20 feet long and 6 feet wide

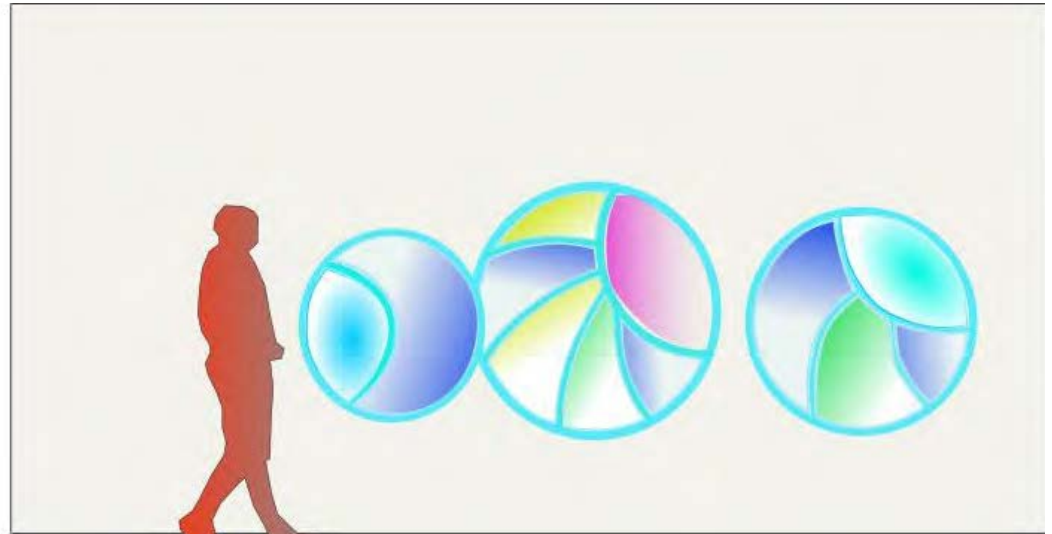

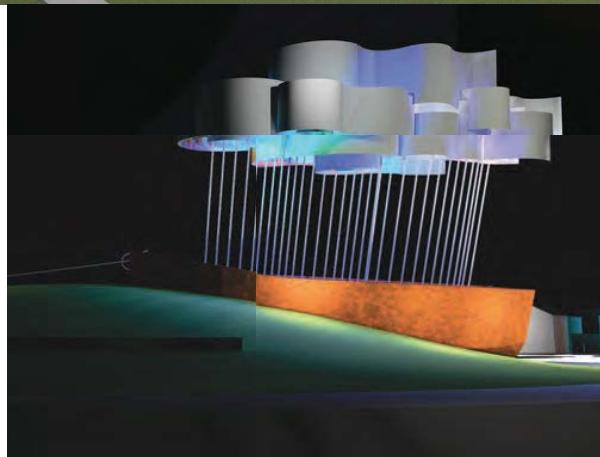
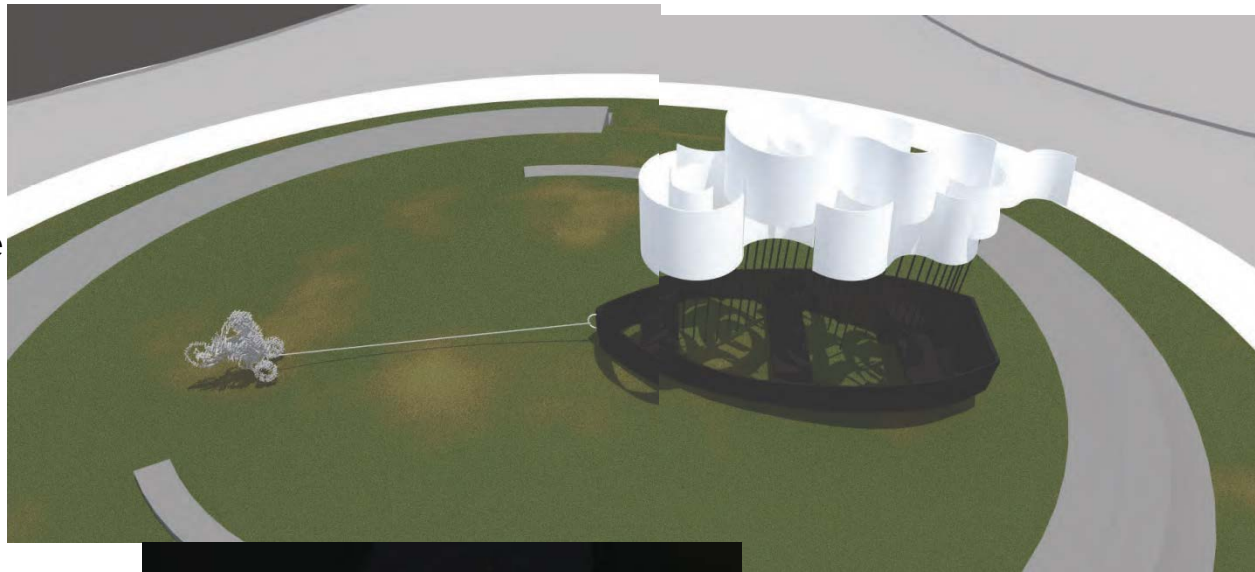

Roundabout 1: By Josh Weiner

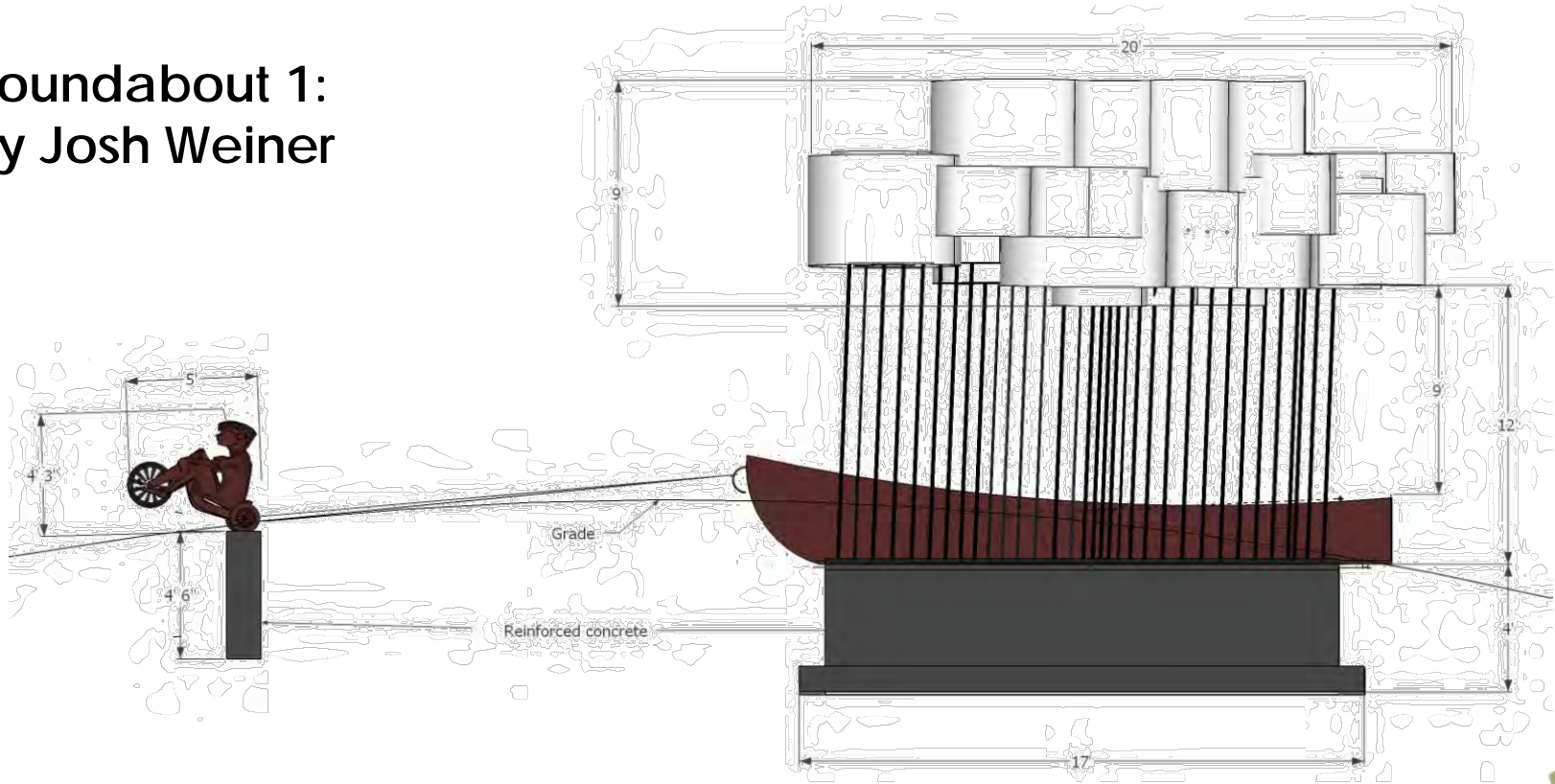

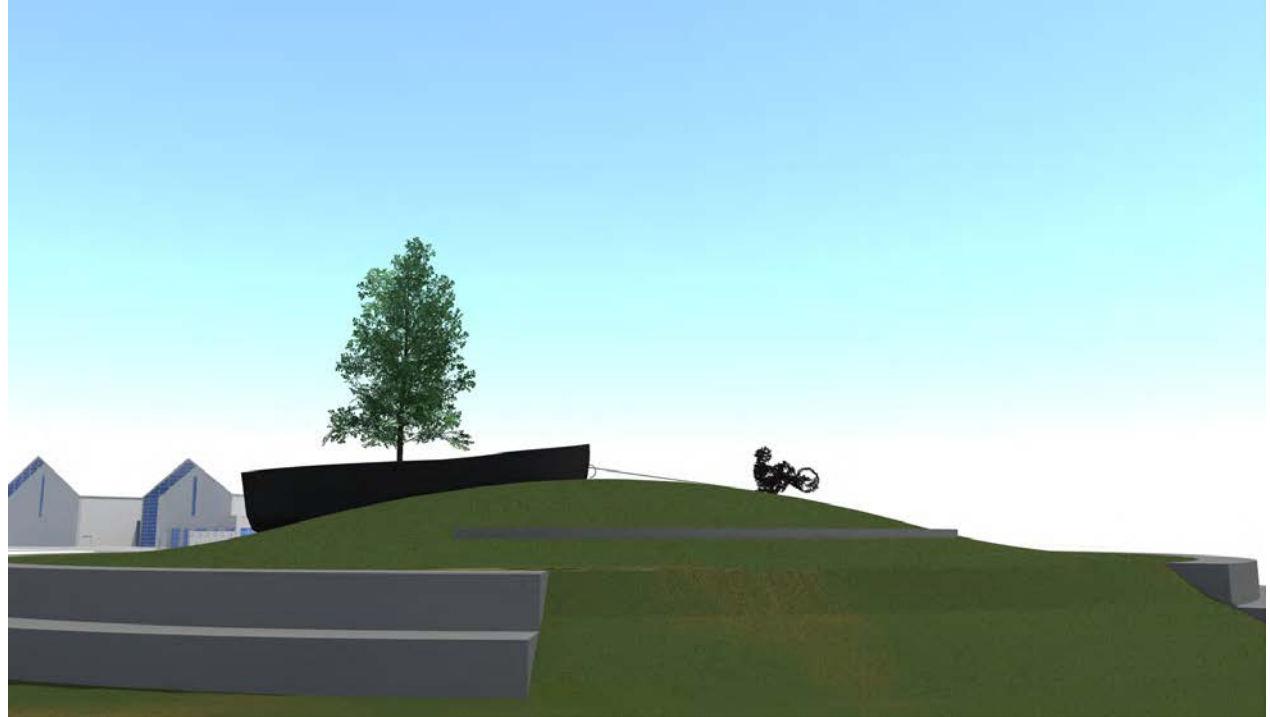
