Program Objectives

- Ensure city rights-of-way and open space areas are maintained in accordance with city ordinances and the Noxious Weed Management Plan
- Improve aesthetics within the community
- Maintain sight lines for motorists and pedestrians
- Proactively plan & complete activities to minimize the occurrence of weeds in public corridors



Program Overview

- Public Works Department maintains the rights-of-way, other City-owned land and open space areas
- Parks, Recreation and Golf Department maintains parks and areas adjacent to trails in open space areas
- Adams County (through a contract with the City) identifies and sprays noxious weeds located within various rights-of-way and open space locations



Program Overview

Type	Acreage	Mowing Frequency
Rights-of-way	128	3 times per mowing season (May –Sept.)
Future park or school sites/City-owned land	116	Once every month (May-Sept.)
Open space	234	As needed to manage weeds
Total	478	

Monitoring & Managing Results

- Utilize asset tracking software (Cartegraph) to accurately track labor, material and equipment usage
- Monitor frequency of mowing operations to ensure staff meets established levels of service
- Adams County & Commerce City share data & photo files (MapItFast) to document areas of weed treatment
- Better able to respond to citizen inquiries and requests
