2018 Priorities for Work Plan Development

Agreement: Priority Outcomes to guide development of 2018 work plan; all outcomes are important and will be worked on, but for 2018 additional focus on objectives for the following outcomes:

- Revenue stability
- Safe, multi-modal travel network
- Fair & impartial administration of justice
- Location of choice for primary employers
- Active living & healthy lifestyles for all residents
- NEW: Culture/Historic (*wording to be developed*)

One outstanding question: What outcome(s) addresses senior issues (e.g. housing, transportation)?

Staff will begin to generate a list of objectives for each of the priority outcomes. Some cursory initial suggestions were made for outcomes that didn't have objectives on the brainstormed list:

- *Revenue stability Objectives:* e.g., seat tax; economic development; and annexations (some)
- *Fair & impartial justice Objectives:* e.g., implement DOJ recommendations; police department practices; ensure all city staff provide services in a fair and impartial manner: legitimacy of police/consistency; and staff/council ensure any policy treats people fairly
- *Location of choice for Employers Objectives:* e.g., DIA cooperation; air-tropolis; and E470/88th ramp
