

WHEREAs, Kate Kramer, the Sand Creek Regional Greenway Partnership (SCRGP) Executive Director has accepted the position of GoWild Northeast Metro Coalition Manager following over thirteen years of service to the SCRGP as the Executive Director;

Whereas, efforts to improve, preserve, and promote the natural, recreational, and cultural resources of the Sand Creek Regional Greenway corridor bear Ms. Kramer's imprint, be it her collaborative work with partners through securing funds in excess of \$17 million, extensive volunteer opportunities and interactive environmental education workshops;
