## RESOLUTION EXPRESSING CITY COUNCIL SUPPORT FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT 27J REFERRED MEASURE 3D NO. 2017-109

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, believes that our young residents deserve a quality education; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that a quality educational system improves the overall stability, well-being and vitality of the Commerce City community by attracting new businesses, residents and job opportunities to the City; and

WHEREAS, Referred Measure 3D will address serve to connect students to technology and digital resources they need to take learning beyond the classroom, launch a resource update cycle enabling 27J students to compete with other Denver Metro districts and retain and recruit high quality teachers and support staff; and

WHEREAS, addressing issues now - for \$.20 a day - is less expensive than waiting to address them down the road and ensures the greatest chance for our youth to succeed and meet our collective vision of a Quality Community for a Lifetime.
