

Fire Impact Fee Proposal

September 11, 2017

Summary

- 2016 The Colorado General Assembly passed House Bill 16-1088
- Brighton Fire and South Adams County Fire District's presented their fee study to City Council and requested to enter into an IGA for the purposes of authorizing them to collect fire impact fees for new development.

Maximum Defensible Fee Amount

- Brighton Fire
 Proposed Impact Fee
 by Land Use
- Commercial (per 1,000 square feet) \$433
- Single family (per dwelling unit) \$688
- Multifamily (per dwelling unit) \$550

- South Adams County Proposed Impact Fee by Land Use:
- Commercial (per square foot) \$0.46 OR \$460
 per1000 Sq. Ft)
- Single family (per dwelling unit) \$732
- Multifamily (per dwelling unit) \$337







Example: SACFPD Proposed Impact Fee Applied to McLane Foodservice

With additional proposed Fire Impact Fee, the total permit fee for the McLane project would've been \$970,312.74

Fire Impact Fee for noncommercial development is proposed to be \$0.46/square foot. The McLane project is 216,169 square feet for a total Fire Impact Fee of \$ \$99,437.74



Recent City Council Actions Related to Development Fees

- Eliminated Parks Impact Fee (commercial & industrial)
- Frozen Escalator for Water Acquisition Fee
 - Future consideration of fees related to:
 - Road Impact Fee; Currently only 40% of the actual cost
 - Drainage Basin Fee is insufficient to address the costs associated with regional drainage improvements



City Council Direction

• If the City Council is interested in further exploring the possibility of authorizing either fire district to collect an impact fee, staff recommends that the City Council consider a motion to move into executive session, for the purposes of instructing negotiators and to receive legal advice from the City Attorney.
