

The result will map out the turn-by-turn directions to lead us to a prosperous future.

The neighborhood currently includes a mixture of residential properties, businesses, industrial centers and even agriculture. Change is already happening in Irondale as new development takes place, so it's important to plan for the future of the area in a thoughtful and collaborative way.

Timeline

Commerce City recently kicked off the project with Ayres Associates conducting an inventory of infrastructure and land uses for the neighborhood. After reviewing the data, we'll host public meetings with the businesses and residents of Irondale, technical advisors and elected officials. The entire planning process is anticipated to run through May 2018.




