WHEREAS, at the direction of Governor Hickenlooper, the Colorado State Patrol recently convened a task force to review first responder safety and has launched its "One Scene. One Culture. Save Lives." campaign; and

WHEREAS, annual roadway fatalities in the Denver region increased by 40 percent between 2014 and 2016; and

WHEREAS, first responders within Commerce City routinely respond to traffic incidents along Interstates and State Highways to protect the public; and

WHEREAS, the upcoming holiday season reinforces the importance of public awareness for first responders, as drivers travel unfamiliar roadways or encounter unpredictable weather.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Commerce City hereby declares support for first responders and urges the public to respect their lives by driving safely and knowing the State of Colorado's Move Over law.
