NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement for Shared Victim Service Unit is found to be in the best interests of the public and for a valid public purpose and is hereby approved.
- 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement for Shared Victim Service Unit, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit A.
- 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute other documents and agreements consistent with accomplishing the purposes of the Intergovernmental Agreement for Shared Victim Service Unit.
