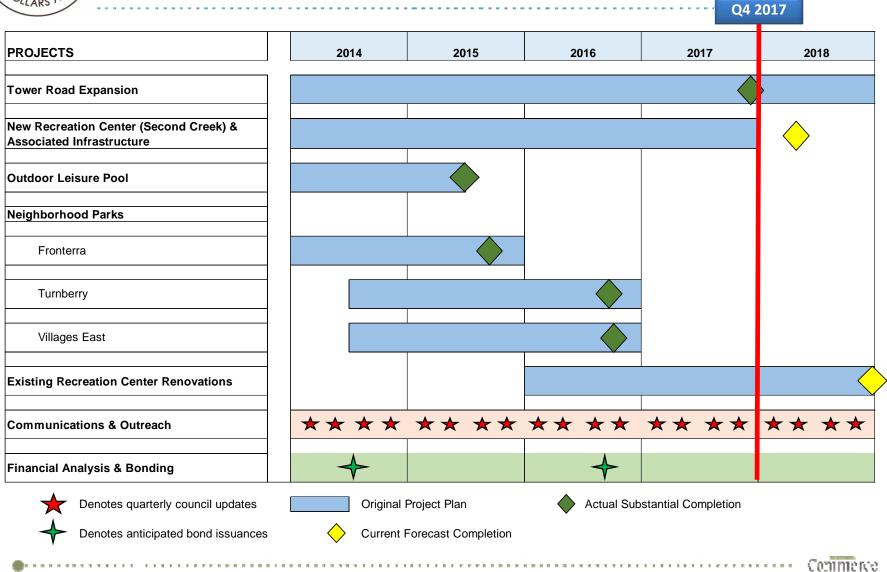

- New 108,000-square-foot building located at the northeast corner of 112th Avenue and Potomac Street
- Contractor: Pinkard Construction
- Designer: Sink Combs Dethlefs
- Construction Began: October 2016
- Facility Opening: Late Spring 2018

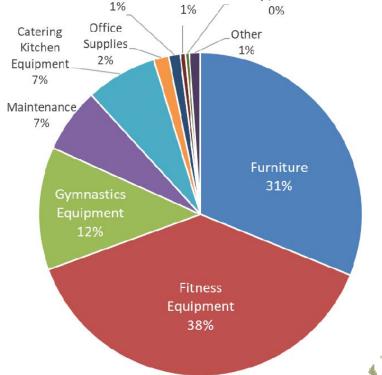

Bison Ridge Rec Center Infrastructure

- Paving of Potomac street north of 108th Ave and 112th Ave from Bison Ridge west to Highway
 2. Extension of utility services to the recreation center site. Highway 2 widening from 112th Ave to I-76
- Contractor: Pinkard Construction (CM/GC)/Flatiron (roadway subcontractor)
- Designer: Fellsburg Holt Ullevig
- Construction Began: September 2016
- Completed: October 2017

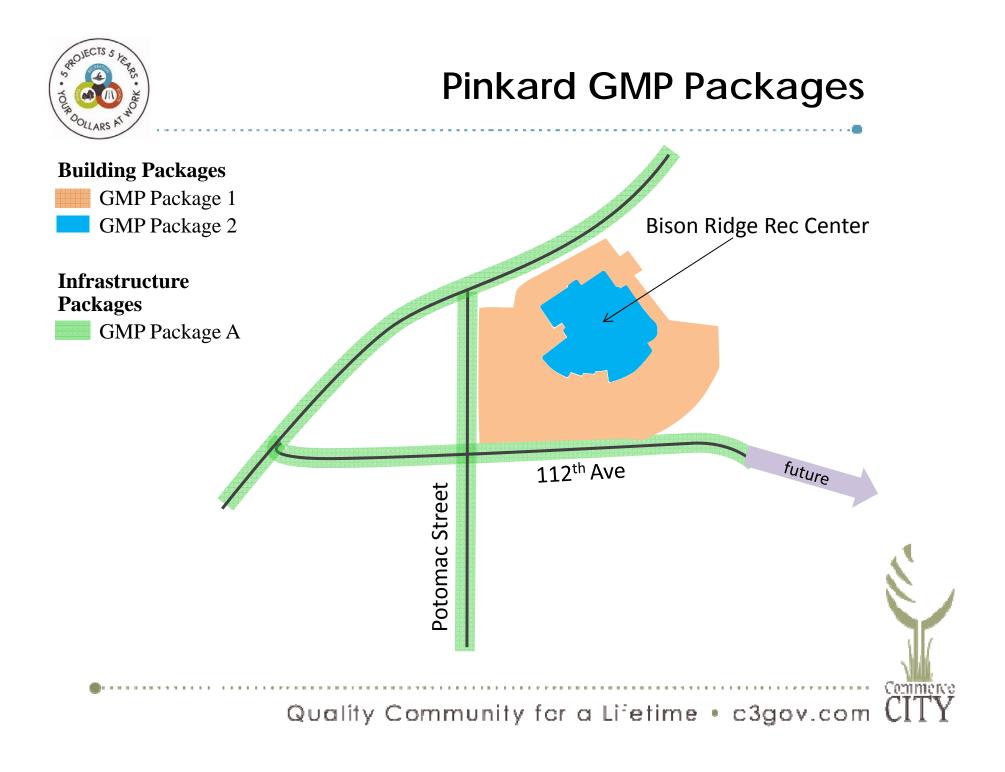


Bison Ridge Rec Center & Infrastructure CM/GC GMP

- Pinkard Construction is the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) for both the Infrastructure Project and the Bison Ridge Recreation Center
- To allow for a fast track delivery of both projects, the guaranteed maximum price (GMP) contract was established as a rolling GMP
 - Initial GMP was established and then updated for each package as design was completed
- Resolution authorized 5% owner contingency to be utilized at discretion of the City Manager
 - Allowed for quick decision making to keep project on schedule
 - All requests follow a change management process, including review by the architect, project management team, and approval by the Executive Team

- Infrastructure exceeded estimated 5% contingency
 - BNSF Right of Way mitigation
 - FRICO negotiations and delay of permit
- Building changes currently at 3% likely to reach 5% at completion
- Bison Ridge project has remaining Construction Contingency budget available

Contract Authorization Increase

- Program Management Team recommends increasing authorization of the City Manager to execute change orders up to full amount of Bison Ridge construction budget
 - Allows for quick actions to keep project on schedule
 - All changes will continue to follow the current process with review by the architect, project management team and approval by the Executive Team
 - Construction Contract value will only be increased by approved Change orders
- Formal Resolution will be presented at the February 5th Council Meeting
