## RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES BY THE COMMERCE CITY POLICE NO. 2018-11

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 33.14.5-110 authorizes the governing body of a city or town to regulate the operation of off-highway vehicles on public lands under their jurisdiction and on streets and highways within its boundaries by resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City of Commerce City is charged with duties to patrol public lands within its jurisdiction that are not accessible in regular and customary patrol vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department of the City Commerce City is charged with duties to patrol streets and highways within boundaries in or under situations or conditions that are not ideally suited for the use of regular and customary patrol vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

The Police Department of the City of Commerce City is hereby authorized to operate off highway vehicles, as that term is defined in C.R.S. § 33-14.5-101, as it exists now or as it may be amended, on public lands within the jurisdiction of the City and on streets and highways within the boundaries of the City.
