

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO PARKS
DIVISION PGW/ROW MAINTENANCE CONTRACT**

NO. 2018-20

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City"), previously awarded a right-of-way maintenance and repair contract to Arrowhead Landscape ("Contractor") anticipating expenditures of approximately \$249,300;

WHEREAS, subsequently the City took possession of 1.4 acres of additional right-of-way which caused an increase in maintenance and repair costs;

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the existing agreement with Contractor to include such right-of-way and costs in an additional amount not to exceed \$116,377;

WHEREAS, the City's procurement approval process requires City Council approval for any contract that expends over \$250,000 and the increased cost of maintaining the additional right-of-way and the cost of any unexpected repairs will cause the existing right-of-way maintenance contract to exceed the sum of \$250,000 before the contract term is completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the proposed amendment to the existing contract with Contractor is appropriate and in the best interest of the citizens of the City and authorizes such amendment.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the amendment to the right-of-way maintenance contract with the Contractor consistent with this resolution.
