RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR EDUCATION ACCESS PROGRAMMING WITH ADAMS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 14 NO. 2018-27

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City), through its cable television franchise agreement with Comcast of Colorado, LLC, and pursuant to federal law, has access to a certain number of channels to be allocated on the cable system that services the City for public, educational, and government ("PEG") access programming use;

WHEREAS, the City and Adams County School District 14 ("District") are parties to an intergovernmental agreement from 2000 that coordinated production and broadcast of government and educational programming through a single channel managed by the District;

WHEREAS, the City and District desire to replace the prior agreement to more accurately reflect the current operating environment and to more fully implement the Franchise Agreement to make use of separate government and educational cable channels managed by the City and District, respectfully;

WHEREAS, the City and District have negotiated the Intergovernmental Agreement for Education Access Programming, attached as Exhibit A ("Intergovernmental Agreement"), to replace the prior agreement and establish the separate operation of government and educational access programming as stated therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement is and shall be in the interest of the public's health, safety, and welfare, for a valid public purpose, and supported by a public need and is hereby approved, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit "A."
- 2. The Mayor and the City Clerk are authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
