You are hereby advised that with regard to the above applications for a medical marijuana-infused products manufacturing license and a medical marijuana optional premise cultivation, an investigation has been made, and based on the results thereof the following has been determined:

- 1) A complete application was filed on or around Jan 8, 2018.
- 2) A notice of public hearing on this matter was published in the Commerce City Sentinel Express on May 1, 2018.
- 3) It appears from the evidence submitted that the applicant will be entitled to possession of the premises where the license is proposed to be exercised.
- 4) The proposed marijuana business is an allowable use of the property.
- 5) A building-permit application was submitted on May 4, 2017.
- 6) The results of the background check uncovered no adverse information.
- 7) A public hearing on the application will be held on May 18, at 1:00 p.m. in the Commerce City Civic Center, 7887 E. 60<sup>th</sup> Ave. Room 2108, Commerce City, CO 80022. At said hearing, you shall have an opportunity to be heard regarding all matters related to the application, including all matters set forth herein.
- 8) At the hearing, the applicant has the burden of proving that they are qualified to hold the license applied for, and their character, record, and reputation are satisfactory; that the neighborhood desires this license be granted.
